Bracy for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Current  
Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Williams at  
or before the sealing & Delivery of these Presents this receipt whereof the  
said Francis Bracy doth hereby acknowledge to the said Bracy hath  
granted bargained and sold & given Entoffed and Confined unto the  
choprements Doth grant bargain and sell alien Entoffed and Conform  
unto the said William Williams his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract  
or parcel of land containing one hundred and fifty Acres more or less  
situate lying and being in Southampton County and bounded as  
followeth Beginning at a Cypress on the said Black water thence  
running a straight course to a pine on the side of Bone Branch then  
a croft the said Branch to a red Oak thence a straight course to another  
Garners line to a pine thence along Garners line to a corner tree  
a white oak thence along the said Garners line to a Dividing line  
between Francis Bracy and David Johnson thence along the said  
line to black water to a pine thence down black water to the first  
station and also all trees woods and under woods Commons and  
Common of pasture & profits Commodities advantages Emoluments  
and hereditaments whatever to the said land above mentioned  
belonging or in any wise appertaining and also revision and  
rescissions remainder and remainders rents and services of the said  
premises and every part thereof right title Interest Claim and demands  
whatsoever of them the said Francis Bracy prior to the same  
premises and every part thereof to have and to hold all and  
singular the said premises above mentioned and every part thereof  
with the appurtenances unto the said William Williams  
his heirs and assigns forever and the said Francis Bracy for  
himself his heirs or assigns the said tract or parcel of land  
with the appurtenances above mentioned and every part thereof  
against them and their heirs executors administrators & assigns  
and against all and every person who shall ever the said  
Williams his heirs executors administrators & assigns  
shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
