 This Indenture witnesseth that the said Joseph Marks for
 consideration of the sum of five shillings by the said Randolph
 Newsum to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he doth hereby
 Acknowledge & for the securing of the payment of the aforesaid sum
 of one hundred and thirty Pounds with Interest to the said Randolph
 Newsum hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth
 bargain and sell unto the said Randolph Newsum his heirs
