Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety Between Benjamin V^{er}se
of the County of Southampton of the one part and Shadrach Johnson of
the same County of the other part witnesseth that the said Benjamin
delivered to Shadrach Johnson for and in Consideration of the sum of six shillings good and lawful
Money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or about the enrolling of these
presents the receipt whereof the said Shadrach Johnson his heirs and assigns
acknowledged with their acquit and discharge the said Shadrach Johnson his heirs and assigns
admits by these presents the said Benjamin V^{er}se have granted
bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these
presents do grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the
said Shadrach Johnson and to his heirs and assigns forever all
that Plantation tract or parcel of land situated lying & being in
the County aforesaid on the south side of Susquehanna Swamp
Containing by estimation one hundred Acres be the same more or
less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a white Oak a
Corner tree in Jean Helen Clarks line thence down the various Courses
of the main Branch to the Susquehanna Swamp
thence up the various Courses of the said Susquehanna
Swamp to a white Oak a Corner tree in Rive Ponces line thence
along a line of marked Trees to a pine a Corner tree in the said
Ponces line thence along a line of marked Trees to a pine a Corner
tree in Jesse Garmers line thence along a line of marked trees to a
white Oak a Corner tree in John Wellons line thence
