This Indenture made this Ninth day of Sept^r in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety, between Christian Denfon William Kitching, & Martha his wife of the County of Southampton Parish of Notoway, of the one part and Jordan Denfon of the Parish and County aforesaid, of the other part Witnesseth that the said Christian Denfon William Kitching and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the just and full sum of fifty two Pounds ten shillings current money of Virginia by the said Jordan Denfon to them in hand paid before the enrolling and signing of these presents the receipt whereof the said Christian Denfon William Kitching and Martha his wife doth hereby acknowledge and therewith acquit and discharge the said Jordan Denfon his heirs and assigns forever and themselves there with fully and intirely satisfied Contented and paid they the said Christian Denfon William Kitching and Martha his wife have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released sold over released & confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release deliver and confirm unto the said Jordan Denfon & to his heirs & assigns forever all that plantation Misquago tract & parcel of land which on the 3^d Nov^r Kitching now lives and being all the lands which the said William Kitching purchased of Jos Kitching by Indenture bearing date Dec^r 1772 Situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Notoway aforesaid Containing by estimation one hundred & seventy five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows To wit^z Beginning at a pine near a small branch a corner of John Blythes land thence north tenderous east one hundred and six pole to a red oak alive tree of the land formerly belonging to Tho^s Gray Des^d thence said line North east one hundred and five pole to a pine thence nearly south by a line of marked trees which divides it from Arthur Bowings lands to a pine in the aforesaid Jordan Denfons (formerly Benjamin Barnes & Co) line and the said line west north west sixty five pole to a pine thence west thirty pole to a pine still west fifty pole to a pine in the aforesaid John Blythes line and the said Blythes line north thirty degrees west forty four pole to the beginning and all the houses out houses edifices buildings woad ways waters & water Courses profits Commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and the revision and reversion remainder &
