 This Indenture made this third day of July in the Year of our
 Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety one Between James Atkinson of the
 County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Dempsey Simmons
 of the said state and County of the other part & Sarah Wick witnesses that
 James Atkinson for and in consideration of the sum of sixty five pounds current
 money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Dempsey Simmons the receipt
 whereof he the said James Atkinson doth hereby acknowledge himself
 fully content therewith hath granted Bargained sold aliened & confirmed
 and by these presents doth fully and absolutely grant bargain sell alien
 and confirm unto him the said Dempsey Simmons his and assigns one certain
 tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and
 parish of St. Lukes by estimation and measure and Twenty five acres be
 the same more or less and Bounded as followeth (To wit) Beginning at
 Turkey oak in George Gurlays line then along the said Gurlays line of
 marks to a pine a corner of the said land also a corner of Council Vicks land
 then along the said Vicks line to a black oak a corner of J. Vicks land also
 another corner of this land in John Jacksons line then then a long the
 said Jacksons line to a white oak in the head of a branch then down
 the said branch to a black gum standing in Benj. Jordans line a corner
 of the said land likewise a corner of the Jacksons land then by a line
 of marks trees bounded by George Gurlays. To the beginning it being
 thus bounded for one hundred and twenty five acres more or less it
 bearing date Nov. 3rd 1750 Together with all houses and buildings
 thereon contained with the reversion and reversions Remainder and
 theriof with the appurtenances to have and to hold the said Bargained
 premises unto the said Dempsey Simmons his heirs and assigns to the
 only proper use and behoof of him the said Dempsey Simmons his
