part and Turner Person of said County of the other part Witnesseth that the
said Richard Clifton for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds
current money of Virginia in hand paid by the said Turner Person to Clifton
before the sealing and delivery of these presents doth receipt whereof the
said Clifton doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and
and Confirmed and by these presents for him self and his heirs doth
Clearly & absolutely grant bargain alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said
Turner Person for and during the lifetime of my wife Dorcas Clifton
all the land the use of which was left to my said wife by her former
husband John Person wife lying on the north side of the Quarter branch
and on the south side of the flats swamp to have and to hold the aforesaid
land with the appertaining unto the said Turner Person for and
during the natural lifetime of my wife as aforesaid that the
said Turner Person shall and may at all times hereafter peaceably
and quietly have hold use and enjoy the above land without the
least trouble or charge whatsoever of or by the said Richard
Clifton his heirs or assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever
lawfully having or claiming any right title or interest in the land
above mentioned or any part thereof and the said Richard Clifton
and his heirs the said land doth hereby warrant and the like
