This Indenture made this eleventh day of January in the year of our
Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred Ninety one between James Wright and
Mary his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of Netoway of the one part
and Albrigtow Jones of the same County and parish aforesaid of the other
part Witnesseth that the said James Wright and Mary his wife for and in consider-
ation of the just and full sum of ninety three pounds ten shillings current
money of Virginia to them in hand paid at or before the enrolling and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof the said James Wright and Mary his wife their heirs
and assigns forever doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the
said Albrigtow Jones his heirs and assigns forever they the said James Wright &
Mary his wife hath granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed and
do by these presents grant bargain sell set over and deliver unto him the said
Albrigtow Jones his heirs and assigns forever two certain tracts of meadows and
parcels of land adjoining each other and one of which the said James
Wright now lives the first mentioned tract containing by estimation one
hundred and seventy acres be the same more or less situated lying and being in
the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Netoway and bounded as
follows to wit beginning at a red oak on the north side of a branch a corner of
the land belonging to the orphans of David Wright deceased thence crossing
the said branch south thirty and degrees east fifty six poles to a red oak
thence south south west seventy two pole a red oak a line tree of Jesse Taynors
land thence along a line of mar hed trees west by north one hundred and sixty
eight pole to a white oak a corner of William Williams land thence by
Williams land north sixty three pole to a pine north forty eight degrees
west six pole to a red oak a corner of William Jones land thence by Howard
Jones land north twenty five degrees east fifty nine pole to a pine by the
side of the tanning branch thence down the various courses of the run
of the said branch to the branch begun ^{upon} and thence up the various
courses of the said branch to the beginning and the other mentioned tract
containing by estimation seventeen acres be the same more or less
and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a pine a corner of Jesse Taynors
land by the side of Anthoneys branch thence by the said Taynors line
north sixty three degrees west forty pole to a red oak a line tree of the
first mentioned tract thence along the said line south east then degrees
