A Court held for the County of Southampton the 10th day of July 1791.
 This Indenture and receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by
 Benjamin Kirby and Ann his wife parties thereto she being first
 privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

I Anne Scott of Southampton County Virginia having under my care the follo-
 wing negroes well as a man aged fifty nine years so a man aged twenty nine
 years Billy a boy born about the last of July one thousand seven hundred
 and eighty one Miles a boy born April one thousand seven hundred and
 eighty six and a woman about forty five years of age and Treasa a girl
 born the tenth day of July one thousand seven hundred & twenty three
 whom I have hitherto held as slaves but being fully persuaded
 that freedom is the natural right of all man kind and that it is my
 duty to do unto others as I would desire to be done by do therefore
 hereby emancipate and set these a free Will So Billy Miles Treasa &
 Treasa of free and I do for myself my heirs executors and administrators
 relinquish all my right title interest and claim or pretention of claim
 whatsoever within to their persons or to any estate they may hereafter
 acquire saving to myself my heirs & assigns the care & direction of the
 said Billy Miles and Treasa until they shall arrive to lawful age
 and then to enjoy their full freedom without any interruption
 from me or any person claiming for by or under me or my heirs
 whosoever I have hereunto set my hand and seal the thirtieth
 day of January in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hun-
 dred and ninety one
