

Know all men by these presents that I John Blythe the elder of Southampton County for the Consideration of the good will love and affections and also for in Consideration of the just and full sum of ten shillings Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by Alexander Blythe before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Blythe doth hereby acknowledge and thereto acquit and discharge himself Alexander Blythe his heirs and assigns and himself therewith fully & intirely satisfied Contented and paid the said John Blythe hath granted & bargained sold set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell set over deliver and Confirm unto the said Alexander Blythe his heirs and assigns forever six head neat Cattle and three head Sheep To have and to hold the said six head of Cattle and three Sheep as aforesaid unto him the said Alexander Blythe his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Alexander Blythe his heirs and assigns forever & the said John Blythe for himself his heirs executors administrators and assigns the said granted Chattle and Sheep unto him the said Alexander Blythe and to his heirs and assigns forever against him the said John Blythe & against his heirs administrators and assigns and against all and every other Person or persons whatsoever Claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said John Blythe hath together with the delivery of the granted Cattle and Sheep hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this the 17th day of January Anno Dom 1791
