This Indenture made the sixth day of July in the Year of our Lord
one Thousand seven Hundred and Ninety, Between Samuel Browne Sen^r and Mary Browne
his wife of the County of Southampton and St. Lu kes Parish in the state of Virginia
of the one part and Albridgeon Jones of the same state and County and Noto way Special
of the other part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred &
thirty pounds Current money of Virginia to the said Samuel Browne Sen^r in hand paid
by the said Albridgeon Jones at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge and and thereof both release
acquit and discharge the said Albridgeon Jones his heirs Executors & assigns by
these presents they the said Samuel Browne Sen^r and Mary Browne his wife hath
granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien and confirm unto the said Albridgeon Jones and his heirs & assigns for
ever a part of a certain tract or parcel of land which the said Samuel Browne Sen^r
bought of his son Jesse Browne lying on the North side of notoway river between
the plantation that Jesse Browne deceased devised to the heirs of his daughter
Reddy Taylor and Noto way river begining at the head of the broad branch or
gully down the various mainders of the said branch by the plantation to notoway
river and up Noto way River to a marked postman tree standing on the middle of the
river and thence leaving the river and running North west ward by a new marked
line of trees to a pine standing on the river bank above the Cabin landing
thence up the said river binding on the same to the first mention ed station
Containing by estimation eighty five acres of land more or less and all houses
as Buildings ways waters water courses profits Commodities hereditaments
and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Premises hereby granted or in
any part thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining and the
reversion and reversions remainder and remainders & rents & profits &
profits thereon and also all the estate right title Interest use trust
property claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Samuel
Browne Sen^r and Mary Browne his wife of in and to the said premises
To have and To hold the land hereby conveyed and all &
