vided he said Albrigton Jones at or before the Sealing and delivery of these presents  
therein, & whereof they doth hereby acknowledge and and there shall hence  
acquit and discharge the said Albrigton Jones his heirs Executors & administrators by  
these presents they the said Samuel Brown Esq<sup>r</sup> and Mary Brown his wife hath  
granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain  
sell alien and confirm unto the said Albrigton Jones and his heirs & assigns forever  
ever a part of a certain tract or parcel of land which the said Samuel Brown Esq<sup>r</sup>  
brought of his son Jepse Brown lying on the North side of Notaway River between  
the plantation that Jepse Brown deceased deeded to the heirs of his daughter  
Ridley Taylor and Notaway river beginning at the head of the broad branch or  
gully down the various mainders of the said branch by the plantation to Notaway  
River and up Notaway River to a mark or persimmon tree standing on the side of the  
river and thence leaving the river and running Northwestwards by a new marked  
line of trees to a pine standing on the river bank above the cabin landing  
thence up the said river binding on the same to the first mentioned station  
containing by estimation eight and a half acres of land more or less and all houses  
Buildings ways waters water courses profits Commodities hereditament  
and appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises hereby granted or in  
any part thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining and the  
reversion and revisions remainder and remainders rents & issues &  
profits hereof and also all the estate right titles interest use trust
