The Commonwealth of Virginia to Robert Goswyn & Hartwell Cocke  
gentlemen greeting Whereas Nicholas Faulcon and Elizabeth his wife  
have by their certain indenture of bargain and sale dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1791  
conveyed unto John Taylor the person before named in an undivided moiety of a certain  
tract or parcel of land situate lying and being on the flat swamp in the County of Southampton  
aforesaid which tract contains four hundred and fifty acres &c which the said  
Faulcon and Sarah Taylor wife of the said John Taylor are tenant in common and  
whereas the said Elizabeth Faulcon cannot conveniently travel to the court  
of law within County to make a acknowledgment thereof therefore we command  
you to go personally to the said Elizabeth and examine her privately and  
apart from her husband whether she hath executed the indenture aforesaid  
freely and voluntarily and whether she is willing the same should be  
recorded in the Court of the said County of Southampton and when you  
have examined her aforesaid that you distinctly and openly certify as  
thereof under your hands and seals returning also to us this writ witness  
Hartwell Cocke of our said Court at his office this 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1791  
and in the 15<sup>th</sup> Year of the Commonwealth
