bear unto the said John Williams their son have bargained sold aliened con-
firmed and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby bargain sell alien and con-
firm and confirm unto the said John Williams his heirs and assigns a certain tract
plain tation or parcel of land lying and being Situate in the County of Southam-
ton and State aforesaid in the town of Paris beginning the lands of John Denson
John Williams Samuel Rowe and Bridget Joyner Bounded as follows to wit
Beginning at a pine standing on Noloway Meadow Corner to the thence
along of marked trees a dividing of this tract to John Williams to the thence
line thence to a pine of said Joyner line to a pine a corner tree thence on
said Joyner line to the Cypress Swamp run thence down the S. Swamp
to a branch thence up the road to said Branch to the beginning containing
by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less and is part of
a patent granted to Arthur Williams & Co. by the said Arthur
conveyed to his son the said William party to these presents together with
all houses out houses gardens wickets and water courses mines &
minerals and all other the profits and commodities thereto
