County aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Richard Markes
Esq and Sarah his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of forty five
pounds Virginia Currency to them in hand paid by the said John Markes
as at before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
he the said Richard Markes Esq doth hereby acknowledge and thereof
acquits and discharge the said John Markes his heirs executors & assigns
forever by these presents Wt the said Richard Markes Esq & Sarah
his wife hath granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm
unto the said John Markes his heirs and assigns forever an certain
tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the said Parish
and County on the north side of Three Creeks beginning at twenty
Oaks in James Barhams line and bounded as follows Wt From the
said two Oaks in the said James Barhams line a north course to a
Shrub Oak thence in East Course to a Shrub Oak a corner tree in
Mary Shavers line thence about her line a north course to a Black
Oak thence to a pine stump a corner tree in Joseph Markes
line thence along the said Joseph Markes line a west course
