that the said James Harrison for and in consideration of the sum of three
three pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before
the enrolling and delivering hereof there receipt whereof is here acknowledged
and the said Robert Evins thereof he the said James Harrison doth hereby
acquit and discharge hath Granted Bargained sold en fofffe released and
confirmed and by these presents doth fully and absolutely Legendant
Bargain sell en fofffe release and confirm unto the said Robert Evins
his heirs and assigns all that Tract or parcel of land containing two
hundred and thirty acres lying and being in the state of Virginia and County
of Southampton it being part of a patent granted to James Cary of 360⁴⁰
Acres. Dift beginning at a live oak in John Everett's land a corner tree
thence south 43° East 250. pole to a red oak thence south 50° west 230
poles to three Oaks chopped inward in Ethelred Warren's line thence north
75° West 10 pole to a pine a corner tree of the said Warrens land thence
along said Warrens line south 6° West 23 pole to three Oaks chopped inward
thence North 73° west 140 pole to the old dividing line in Robert Evins
other land thence along the old adjoining line north 26° East to the
Beginning 367 pole together with all Buildings thereon and thereunto
and executors Remainder and remainders rents and profits there
and of every and parcel thereof with the appurtenances To him 52^{1/2}
acres with all edifices profits privileges and appurtenances to him
Robert Evins his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and benefit
of the said Robert Evins his heirs and assigns forever he doth by
saying the ducments thereon according and the said James Harrison
for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth covenant and agree
