that the said John Jayner and Ann his wife their heirs and assigns for
in consideration of the just and full sum of Fifteen pounds current money
of Virginia by the said Joshua Jayner to them in hand paid at or before
the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the
John Jayner and Ann his Wife doth hereby acknowledge and they
quit and discharge the said Joshua Jayner his heirs and assigns forever
and themselves their heirs fully and completely satisfied and contented
with the said Joshua Jayner and Ann his wife have granted bargained
sold released and delivered with these presents released and confirmed
by these presents do grant bargain sell release and confirm
unto the said Joshua Jayner his heirs and assigns forever all that
messuage tract and parcel of land whereon the said Joshua Jayner
now lives and situated lying and being in the aforesaid county
of Southampton and parish of Notoway containing by estimation
