 Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety, an Between Howell Myrick
 and Hannah his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
 of the one part and Thomas Peter of the aforesaid County and State of
 Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said Howell Myrick and Hannah
 his wife hath for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and
 twenty pounds Virginia Currency to him in hand paid by the said Thomas
 Peter the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed both
 by the said Howell Myrick and sold and sold by the said presents bargain grant
 and sell to the said Thomas Peter his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 tract or parcel of Land containing two hundred Acres be the same
 more or less lying and being in the aforesaid County and is the land
 the said Howell Myrick purchased of James Bullard as by
 deed recorded in the County Court of Southampton will more fully
 appear and bounded by the lands of the said Thomas Peter that of
 Wiggins John Applewight and the estate of Samuel Nicolson dead
 on the North side of the three Creeks and on the eedy branch
 together with all woods and waters ways waters and water courses
 profits commodities Advantages Emolument and Hereditaments
 whatsoever to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining
 and also the reversion and reversions and remainder and remainders
 rents and services of all and singular the said premises and every
 part and parcel thereof with the appertinances therunto belong-
 ing. To have and To hold the said tract or parcel of Land and
 premises with the appertinances To the said Thomas Peter his
 heirs and assigns forever the said Howell Myrick and Hannah
 his wife sold for themselves and their heirs covenant and agreed to and
 with the said Thomas Peter his heirs and assigns that they will warrant
 and for ever defend the above granted Tract or parcel of Land and Premises
 and assigns against the claim or demand of them The said Howell
 Myrick & Hannah his wife & their heirs and against the
