This Indenture made the ninth day of June in the year
of our lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one between Tho:
Pate and Mary his wife of the county of Southampton and parish of
Saint Luke of the one part and John Davis of the same County and parish
of Netoway of the other part Whereat one Thomas Gray the elder late
of the county of Southampton was in his life time seized and possessed
of and certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation near
hundred and sixty acres lying and being in the said County of Southampton
and parish of Netoway ^{in Netoway} which at the time of his death descended
to Thomas Gray his eldest son and heir at law who by an certain
Indenture bearing date the eighth day of July 1763 mortgaged the
said Lands to Gray Briggs of the County of Devon die the equity of
redemption whereof was foreclosed by decree of the court of the County of
Devon die in chancery by virtue of which decree the said Gray Briggs
exposed the said lands to publick sale and one Thomas Wells became the
purchaser and by an certain indenture bearing date the sixteenth
day of July 1771 the said Gray Briggs conveyed the fee simple
estate of the said nine hundred and sixty acres of land to the said
Thomas Wells his heirs and assigns and whereas the said Thomas
Wells by an Indenture bearing date the tenth day of September
1772 sold and conveyed to Jordan Tenson in fee simple the
