of the sum of thirty two pounds ten shillings to him in hand paid at or
before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he
doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened and offered
and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
and confirm unto the said Rice B. Pierce and his heirs forever one certain
tract or parcel of land situate and being in the County aforesaid and
containing eighty acres or less or more and bounded as
followeth Beginning at a pine tree corner tree in William Williams lines
thence by Williams line to Charles Briggs line thence by his line
to the great branch thence down the said branch to the old Indian
line thence by the said Indian line to the Beginning to have and
and to hold the said eighty acres of land with the appurtenances
thereunto belonging unto the said Rice B. Pierce his heirs and assigns
forever and the said William Spivey doth for himself and his heirs
farther covenant and agree with the said Rice B. Pierce his heirs
and assigns that the said William Spivey his heirs &c shall and will
warrant and forever defend the right and title of the above mentioned
land and premises unto the aforesaid Rice B. Pierce his heirs and
assigns against the claim of all and every Person or Persons whatso
ever In witness whereof the said William Spivey hath hereunto
set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written
