This Indenture made the fift day of July 1794 Between Land
 Allicom and Rebecca his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part
 and John Kindred of the same County of the other part witnesseth
 that the said Samuel Allicom and Rebecca his wife for and in Considera-
 tion of the sum of one hundred and seventy five pounds specie to them
 in hand paid at or before the sealing of these presents the Receipt
 whereof they do hereby Acknowledge have granted Bargained and sold
 Alien'd & conveyed Confirm'd and made over and do by these presents
 for them selves their heirs & and all every of them Grant bargain well
 alien out off Confirm and make over unto the said John Kindred his
 heirs and assigns forever all their right title Interest Claim and demand
 that has been conveyed to them in a Deed in Southampton Court from
 William Hoines and Wife and John Powell and his wife all that tract
 or parcel of land which the said Samuel Allicom purchased of
 the said Hoines and Powell Situate lying and being in the County of
 Southampton the North side of the flat Swamp containing by
 estimation three hundred and twenty seven Acres by the same Land
 or less and Bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a white oak
 stand on Cores Swamps a Corner of James Turners Land (in the old
 Pattern mentioned thence along James Turners Line to Benjamin
 Turners line from thence along Benjamin Turners line to James
 Porters Line thence along James Porters line to Bunters Barnes
 line from thence along Bunters Barnes line to the flat Swamp
 thence up the flat Swamp to Cores Swamps thence up Cores Swamps
 to the Beginning To have and to hold with all and singular its
 appurtenances therein belonging unto the said John Kindred
 his heirs and assigns forever and the said Samuel Allicom and Rebecca
 for themselves their heirs executors Admors & do each Covenant grant
 and agree to and with the said John Kindred his heirs & shall
 from time to time after the 25th of Dec^r next peaceably & quietly
 enter possess and enjoy the said Land and premises herein mentioned or in-
 terposed to be hereby granted without any lawful suit Let Trouble or
 interruptions of them the said Samuel Allicom and Rebecca his wife
 their heirs executors admors to or any other of his person or persons
 claiming by or under them and the said Samuel Allicom Rebecca
 his wife their heirs & all their right title and Interest as has been
 conveyed to them by the aforesaid Hoines & Powell to the said
