bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed by these presents

Brittain Bryant his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or
parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton a part
containing by estimation two hundred and fifty Acres both
more or less the said dividend of land being part of a tract
granted by deed of giftment unto the said Nathan Bryant
