This Indenture made the Twenty ninth day of July in the year  
 four lord one thousand seven hundred and eight eight Between Francis  
 Pennise of Southampton County in the State of Carolina of the one part  
 and Jacob Turner of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the other  
 part witnesseth that for and In consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds  
 current Money of Virginia to me in hand paid by the said Jacob Turner  
 The receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge before the enscaling and  
 Delivering of these presents have granted bargained and sold unto  
 the said Jacob Turner his heirs and assigns forever all and singular  
 that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of  
 Southampton aforesaid and bounded by the most known ancient  
 and reputed Bounds thereof Beginning at a corner tree which  
 is a gum in Jacobs branch thence along a line of marked trees to  
 Craffords road from thence along the said road to the little buck  
 horn Creek or Swamp thence along the said water course to the wash  
 thence down the wash by the water course to Jacobs Branch thence  
 along the said branch to the Beginning containing one hundred & fifty  
 acres more or less to have and to hold the said land with all  
 the appertinances thereunto belonging with all other advantages or  
 Emoluments thereto in anywise pertaining to him the said Jacob Turner his  
 heirs and assigns forever in as full and ample manner as the said  
 Francis Pennise formerly enjoyed it and for the more & the said  
 Francis Pennise do and for myself my heirs &c. shall and will warrant  
 and forever defend the aforesaid premises against me my heirs and so forth  
 and against all persons whatsoever to the said Jacob Turner and his  
 heirs forever In witness whereof have hereunto set my hand and
