deed from her said husband Whether she doth the same voluntarily
and freely without the persuasion or threats of her said husband and
whether she is willing that the same should be recorded in the Court of
Southampton. When you have examined her and approved the same
and plainly certify us thereof under your hands and Seal returning unto us
also this writ with Saml Kellys Clerk of said Court of Southampton
at his Office The 1st day of November 1799 in the 14th Year of the
Commonwealth
