This Indenture made this 5th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one Between Ephraim Williams of Southampton County and state of Virginia of the one part and Nathan Williams of the said County and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said Ephraim Williams for & in consideration of the sum twenty five pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand before the undersigned and delivery of the sum to the said Benjamin Todd and delivered and sold by these present parties Benjamin Todd and delivered unto the said Nathan Williams a certain tract or parcel of land lying and in the County aforesaid containing by estimation fifty acres more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a red Oak a corner tree in Edmond Barrell's line thence along the said Barrell's line to a pine a corner tree in James Barrell's line thence a black gum a corner tree of James Barrell's and Jacob Williams thence along the said
