made, agreed and concluded on the
second day of April in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven
hundred and ninety one between Robert H. Fisher of the county of Pitt
and state of Virginia the one part and Jacob Daughtrey of the same
county and state of record in the other part Witnesseth that the said
Robert H. Fisher for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds
good and ^{law} legal money by the said Jacob Daughtrey to him in hand
paid at the sealing and delivering hereof the receipt whereof is
duly hereby acknowledged he the said ^{Robert} Fisher hath granted sold
aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
begin sell alien release and confirm unto the said Jacob Daughtrey
his heirs and assigns for ever and a Tract or parcel of land containing
two hundred and fifty four acres lying on the west side of Blackwater
river in Southampton County and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning
at a Vine on the river side James Gardner's line his corner tree and
running thence bounding on the said Gardner's South thirty six and half
degrees west two hundred and sixty nine poles to a pine on the said
Gardner's line thence north thirty six degrees west twenty six poles to
a pine thence north twenty one and a half degrees east one hundred
and seventy poles to a pine thence north fifty nine degrees east
One hundred and eighty four poles bounding on the old County line
to a Cypress standing by the river side thence down the said Black
water river along the several courses thereof to the first station
with all waots and increase commons of pastures profits commodities
advantages emolument and hereditaments whatsoever to the said
land above mentioned belonging or in any wise appertaining or in or
upon the same growing happening or arising and also the reversion
and reversions remainder and remainders rents and services of the
said premises and every part thereof and also all the as later
right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the said
Robert H. Fisher of in or to the said premises and every part thereof
to have and to hold all and singular of the said premises and
every part thereof with their appertinances unto the said Jacob
Daughtrey his heirs and to the only use and behoof of him the D.
Jacob Daughtrey his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Robert
H. Fisher for him and his heirs the said parcel of land with
the appertinances thereto belonging against him the D.
Robert H. Fisher his heirs and assigns and against all and
every other person or persons whatsoever the said
