This Indenture made this seventh day of October 1791
Between William Edmunds and his wife Martha of Southampton County of the one part and Thomas Fitzhugh of the said County of the other part
witnesseth that the said William Edmunds and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of sixty seven pounds four shillings current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Fitzhugh the receipt whereof we the said William Edmunds and Martha his wife doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Fitzhugh his heirs and assigns and their Tractors parcel of land Situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by survey one hundred and twelve acres more or less and Bounded as followeth Beginning at a red oak on the side of Thomas Hollidays Road that leads to the Court House from his House Running S 75 Degrees E 60 pole to a corner gum in the head of the spring branch By the side of Nathan Johnsons Fence then down the various courses of the said branch S 15 D E 34 pole then still down the said Branch south 10 Degrees E 30 pole to a corner white oak in the mouth of the horse meadow branch then up the said Branch N 42 Degrees East 60 pole then North 50 D East 60 pole then N 106 Pole up the said horse meadow branch to Thomas Fitzhughs line then N 30 D West 114 Pole to a corner Black Jack on Hollidays Road then along the side of the said Road South 35 D West 23 pole then S 51 D West 116 pole then along the said Road to the first Station together with all houses orchards woods Timbers Trees water ways
