for the use and of the time from the date hereof until the
expiration of the time from which the aforesaid Lease was granted by the
said Court unto the said Henry Adams to have and to hold the said lot
and parcel of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto
belonging to the said John Wright his heirs and assigns forever to the
only proper use and behoof of the said John Wright his heirs and assigns
forever and the said Henry Adams and his wife doth for themselves
and their heirs further covenant and agree with the said John Wright
his heirs and assigns that the said Henry Adams and his wife Mary
Adams their heirs Executors administrators and successors shall not
will warrant nor defend the above mentioned Lot and premises unto
the said John Wright his heirs and assigns for the above term against
the claim or title of all and every person or persons whatsoever in
