 Trust hereby intended to be made to the said Simon Baykin is at his request
 and that all transactions legally made done or performed by him the said
 Simon Baykin according to the true intent and meaning expressed in the
 deed before mentioned shall be firm stable and binding on him the said Jacob
 his heirs executors and administrators in witness whereof the parties have
