This Indenture made this sixteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one between Edwin Simmons and Rebecca his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of Nottoway of the one part and Drury Williams of the same county and parish of the other part witnesseth that the said Edwin Simmons and Rebecca his wife for and in consideration of the just and full sum of fifty one pounds current money of Virginia by the said Drury Williams to them in hand paid before the enrolling & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Edwin Simmons and Rebecca his wife doth hereby acknowledge and that of acquit and discharge the said Drury Williams his heirs and assigns forever and themselves therewith fully and entirely satisfied Contented and paid they the said Edwin Simmons and Rebecca his wife have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release set over deliver and confirm unto the said Drury Williams and to his heirs and assigns for ever all that plantation messuage tract and parcel of land whereon Peter Tenson now lives situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Nottoway of the one part
