To all to whom these presents shall come Whereas one James Vick of the County
of Southampton by his certain indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 1st August 1790
did sell and convey unto Jordan and Joseph Benson and to their heirs and assigns an certain
Tract or parcel of land whereon he the said James Vick did live lying in the County
of Southampton and parish of Stoteway containing one hundred and twenty
acres be the same more or less for the consideration and receiving the
payment of Forty one pounds with interest then justly due to the said Jordan
and Joseph Benson from the said James Vick with a provision of redemption
on the payment of the aforesaid sum and interest to the said Jordan and Joseph
Benson their heirs Executors administrators or assigns And whereas the said James
Vick hath paid and satisfied the said Jordan and Joseph Benson the aforesaid
sum of forty one pounds and the interest arising thereon to the date hereof Now
know ye that in the said Jordan and Joseph Benson for the consideration aforesaid
have and by these presents do give release and forever quit-claim unto the aforesaid
James Vick and to his heirs and assigns all the right title interest claim or demand
of them the said Jordan and Joseph Benson their heirs Executors administrators
or assigns of or to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land mentioned to be conveyed
in and by the aforesaid indenture of Mortgage herein before mentioned and
we do hereby acquit and discharge the aforesaid James Vick his heirs Executors
administrators and assigns from the said debt and demand Witness our hands
and seals the 11th day of October 1799
