To all whom these presents shall come Whereas one James Vick of the County  
of Southampton by his certain indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 1<sup>st</sup> August 1790  
did sell and convey unto Jordan and Joseph Denson and to their heirs and assigns an uncertain  
Tractor parcel of land wherein he the said James Vick did live lying in the County  
of Southampton and parish of Halloway containing one hundred and twenty  
acres be the same more or less for the consideration and sume aforesaid the  
payment of Fifty one pounds with interest thereon yearly due to the said Jordan  
and Joseph Denson from the said James Vick with a provision of redemption  
on the payment of the aforesaid sum and Interest to the said Jordan and Joseph  
Denson their heirs Executors administrators or assigns And whereas the said James  
Vick hath paid and satisfied the said Jordan and Joseph Denson theforesaid  
sum of forty one pounds and the Interest arising thereon to the date hereof NOV  
Know ye that we the said Jordan and Joseph Denson for the consideration aforesaid  
have and by these presents do remise release and forever quit Claim unto the aforesaid  
James Vick and to his heirs and assigns all the right title interest claim or demand  
of them the said Jordan and Joseph Denson their heirs executors administrators  
or assigns of or to the aforesaid tractor parcel of land mentioned to be conveyed  
in and by the aforesaid indenture of Mortgage herein before mentioned and  
we do hereby acquit and discharge the aforesaid James Vick his heirs executors  
administrators and assigns from the said debt and demand with these our hands  
and seals this Eleventh day of October 1790 and
