

This Indenture made this tenth day of November

in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one between
the said Wines of the County of Southampton of the one part and Edward
Harris of the same County of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said
Edward Harris had given the said William Wines a Deed of Trust for the lands
and plantation whereon the said Harris now lives being in two portions -
situate and lying in the County of Southampton on the south side of the
three Crib and bounded by the most known and reputed bounds containing
by estimation four hundred and five acres be the same more or less bearing
date the third day of November one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine
in order to secure the payment of the sum of four hundred and sixty two pounds
seven shillings and eight pence specie with interest thereon untill paid
on which said Debt and interest has been fully paid by the said Harris on
or before the making and delivery of this present the Receipt whereof the
said Wines doth hereby acknowledge and doth therefore by these
present for himself and his heirs grant and relinquish unto the said
Edward Harris and his heirs all the right full interest claim and demand
whatsoever in and to the aforesaid four hundred and five acres of land
which was granted him the said Wines by Virtue of the Deed of Trust given
him by the said Harris To have and to hold to the only proper use of
him the said Harris and his heirs forever in witness whereof
the said Wines has hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day
and Year first above written
