This Indenture made this eleventh day of February in the year
since Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between Joel Wood
Mary his wife and Charles Briggs of the Parish of Walling in the
County of Southampton on the one part and William Crislow of the
Parish of St. Mary in the County of Westchester on the other part
Witnesseth that the said Joel Wood Mary his wife and Charles Briggs for and in consideration of the
value of thirty pounds to them in Law paid the receipt whereof
they do hereby acknowledge have given granted bargain and sold
Quint and confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain sell
confer and confirm unto him the said William Crislow his certain inter-
est his heirs and assigns forever an certain Tract or parcel of Land
lying and being in the Parish and County aforesaid containing Sixty
Acres more or less and bounded as follows Beginning at a Pine stake
on the side of Hunters Road thence along north westerly 135
Pole to a red oak on the said Bottom line thence along his line N. 33
E. 223 Pole to the Indian Branch thence down the
Branch 126 Pole to a maple in William Crislow's line thence
along his line S 30. E. 1100 Pole to the beginning to have and to hold the
said sixty acres of Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto
belonging unto the said William Crislow his heirs and assigns forever
to the use and behoof of the said William Crislow his
heirs and assigns forever and the said Joel Wood Mary his wife
and Charles Briggs doth for them selves and their heirs further covenant
and agree with the said William Crislow his heirs and assigns that the
said Joel Wood Mary his wife and Charles Briggs their heirs executors &
administrators shall and well warrant and for ever defend the
above mentioned lands and premises unto the said William
Crislow his heirs and assigns for ever defend the above mentioned
title of all and every person or persons whatsoever in witness where-
of we have set our hands affixed our Seals this day and year
above written
