This indenture made the ninth day of January in 1811

Between our Lord and Lady his wife and Charles Briggs of the County of Middlesex  
and that under Mary his wife and Charles Briggs of the County of Middlesex  
in the County of South Hampton of the one part and Samuel Drewry of the  
County of South Hampton of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Joel Wood and  
Mary his wife and Charles Briggs for and in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds  
now shillings and five pence to them in hand paid the receipt whereof they do hereby  
acknowledge have given granted bargain sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by  
these presents do give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said  
Samuel Drewry his certain attorney his heirs and assigns for ever an certain  
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the Parish and County of South Hampton contain-  
ing one hundred and eighty three acres be the same more or less and bounded  
as follows Beginning at a dead stump on Founters road thence along the said  
Drewrys old line westwardly to the main Run of the of the moose swamp  
thence up the main run of the said swamp to Thomas Buttes line thence  
along his line westwardly to Winters road and thence along Winters road  
northwardly to the Beginning together with all houses out houses yards  
gardens orchards woods under woods ways waters and water courses prewidges  
profits commodities hereditaments and appertinances to the same belonging  
or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainder and  
remainders rent issues and services thereof with all the estate right title  
interest claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Joel Wood and Mary  
his wife and Charles Briggs often and to the said tract and parcel of land and  
premises with the appertinances thereunto belonging or of in and to every part  
and parcel thereof with all Deeds evidences and writings Touching or any  
way concerning the same To have and to hold the said tract and parcel of  
land and premises with the appertinances unto him the said Samuel Drewry  
his certain attorney his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof  
of him the said Samuel Drewry his certain attorney his heirs and assigns  
forever and the said Joel Wood and Mary his wife for themselves their  
heirs executors and administrators do covenant grant and agree to & with  
the said Samuel Drewry that they the said Joel Wood and Mary  
his wife their heirs executors and administrators the said tract or  
parcel of land and premises with the appertinances to him the said  
Samuel Drewry his certain attorney his heirs executors and adminis-  
trators and assigns from and against the claim and demand of them  
the said Joel Wood and Mary his wife their heirs executors and  
administrators and from and against the claim and demand of all and every  
other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and
