This Indenture made this tenth day of November in the year one
 Thousand seven hundred and ninety one Between Edward Harris of Southampton
 County of the one part and James Harris of the aforesaid County of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Edward Harris for and in Consideration of the sum of one
 hundred and twelve pounds ten shillings Current money to him in hand well and truly
 paid by the said James Harris the Receipt whereof the said Edward Harris
 doth hereby acknowledge to the said Edward Harris hath granted bargained
 and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
 bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Harris his heirs
 and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land Situate lying and being in the
 County of Southampton and on the South side of the three creeks and bounded
 as followeth (To wit) Beginning at a point on the south side of the three
 Creeks a corner of the said Edward Harris's old land thence by the s^d Harris
 line south ten degrees east twenty poles to a hickory south west by south
 forty six poles to black oak and west twenty poles to a light wood post
 a corner of John Myrick's land thence by the said Myrick's line south
 fifteen degrees east twenty poles to a stake a corner of Elizabeth
 Lundy's land thence by the s^d Lundy's line south twenty
