the Year of our Lord God one thousand seven Hundred and eighty eight Between
Arthur Turner of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas C. Patrick of the
aforesaid County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Arthur Turner for and in
Consideration of the sum of Fifty two pounds Current Money of Virginia to him
in hand paid by the aforesaid Thomas C. Patrick the receipt whereof he doth
hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
do grant bargain and sell unto the aforesaid Thomas C. Patrick and to his heirs
and assigns forever all that Tract or parcel of Land which the aforesaid
Arthur Turner formerly purchased of Elijah Crocker late of the aforesaid
County containing by survey one Hundred and fourteen acres and bounded
as followeth to wit Beginning at John Blunts corner gum in Browns
branch thence North 50 East 51 Pole to Hardy Hariges corner pine then
South 75 East 90 Pole to a corner walnut tree in an old field then
South 20 East 180 Pole to a corner Hickory then South 30 West 40
Pole to a corner red Oak then North 45 West 28 Pole to Browns
branch then up the said branch to the beginning and all Houses
and Lanes Fences Orchards Trees Ways Waterse water Courses
Profits Commodities Hereditaments and appertinances to the
said Tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining
