This Indenture made this thirtieth day of December one
thousand seven hundred and ninety one Between Edmund Barrell and Jesse
Barrell of Southampton County Wilkesbath that the said Edmund Barrell
for the sum of five shillings current Money of Virginia hath granted
and confirmed and by these presents doth forever grant and confirm unto the
said Jesse Barrell his heirs and assigns one hundred and eighty acres
of land in the County aforesaid bounded as follows to wit beginning
at a gum in the flat branch a corner tree of Nathan Williams
land thence north sixty two degrees east two hundred and fifteen pole
thence north thirty seven degrees East twenty eight pole to a pine
thence south fifteen degrees east thirty eight pole to a light wood
post thence north thirty three degrees west and
