in killing* This Indenture of two parts made this the 2th day of October in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety one Between James Bennett of the one part of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia and Wm. Farrell of the said County and state, witnesseth That for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings by the said Bennett to the said Farrell in hand paid the receipt whereof the said Farrell doth hereby acknowledge before the sealing and acknowledging the premises, as well for and in consideration of the further sum of thirty five pounds by the said James Bennett paid and herein and hereby acknowledged by the said Farrell to have been received before the sealing and delivery of these presents he the said Farrell doth for himself his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever relinquish make over alien and resign all his rights title and interest of what nature or equality whatsoever in and to the estate whereof Ann Ricks of this the said County of Southampton and state of Virginia hath died seized and possessed to him the said James Bennett his heirs executors administrators and assigns to the only proper use of him the said Bennett his heirs executors and administrators forever upon this special provision nevertheless That he the said Bennett shall refund and pay back to the said William Farrell all sum and sums of money which shall remain due to the said William Farrell from the estate of the said Ann Ricks after deducting the sum of thirty five pounds from the same with interest on the same from the date of these presents he the said Bennett having ten days previous notice given him by the said Farrell to refund to him the balance if any
