of the parish and county aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said
James Wilson Coker and Martha Coker for and in consideration of the sum
of forty pounds Specie to him in hand paid by the said Arthur Eum
the receipt whereof the said James Wilson Coker and Martha Coker
doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said
Arthur Eum his heirs executors and administrators by these presents
Have and each of them hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed
and confirmed and by these presents do and each of them doth grant
bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Arthur Eum &
to his heirs and assigns forever all that Tract or parcel of Land situate
lying and being in the parish and County aforesaid and on the north
side of the ruddy branch containing seventy five acres more
or less and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a poplar in
the ruddy branch thence following Arthur Eums line North
