This Indenture made this 10th day of April 1792 Between James

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Turner of Warren County North Carolina of the one part and John Jones of
Southampton County and State of North Carolina of the other Witnesseth that the
said James Turner for the sum of Eleven hundred and eighty five pounds or
current money of Virginia to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is
acknowledged has granted bargained and sold aliened unspoffed vested and
confirmed and sold by these presents grant bargain and sell alien unspoff
release and confirm to the said John Jones a parcel of land in Southampton
County Virginia containing Eleven hundred and eighty six acres more or
less bounded thus Beginning at a large gum in the County line on the bank of Mc-
Kinn River thence an East line along the said County line to a corner to the
oak in Edmund Turners line thence a straight line to Edmund Turners line
at a place known by a tree thence along said line to the mouth of the Passacon
branch thence to Arthur Turners line thence along D Turners line to B Turners
branch thence down said D Turners branch to the head of a ditch left by
Edmund line thence down said ditch to the end thereof in a mark thence down the
said Swash as the same meanders to a path that crosses the same known by
the name of Blueste path thence a direct line to the great Swash at Smiths crossing
to the middle of said great Swash thence down the same to the fork thence down
the Westernmost fork as the same meanders to the fort station And all the rights
title Interest and estate of said James Turner in the said parcel of land to have and to
hold the said parcel of land and appurtenances to said John Jones his heirs and assigns
forever and the said James Turner for him self his heirs Executors and administrators
doth covenant with said John Jones to warrant and defend the said parcel of land
and appurtenances to him the said John Jones his heirs and assigns forever
against the lawful claim of all persons whatsoever In witness whereof the s.
