This Indenture made this twenty first day of January in the Year
four Lord Christone thousand seven hundred and ninety two Between John
Williamson of the state of North Carolina of the one part and Valentine Jenkins of
the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that
the said John Williamson for and in consideration of the sum of Forty five pounds
current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Valentine Jenkins
on or before the sealing and delivering these presents the receipt whereof he
the said John Williamson doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and
discharge the said Valentine Jenkins his heirs Executors and administrators
hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by
these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release enfeoff and confirm
unto the said Valentine Jenkins and to his heirs and assigns forever
a certain plantation tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County
of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation Twenty seven acres be
the same more or less which said plantation or tract of land was purcha
sed by Robert Williamson of Edmund Jenkins and conveyed by a deed
bearing date the 13th day of December in the year 1759 which said
has been duly proved and recorded in the Court of the County of
Southampton aforesaid and by the said Robert Williamson devised
by his last will and Testament to his nephew John Williamson
Party hereto and is bounded as followeth To wit Begining at
the mouth of the landing neck branch so up the said branch
to a branch call'd the turkey branch so up the said branch to a
red oak standing upon the branch side then along a line of marked
trees to a pine in the head of a branch call'd the lower Branch
