This Indenture made this fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between Henry Jones of the County of Southampton and parish of Nettonway of the one part and John Davis administrator of Isaac Williams died of the County and parish aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry Jones for and in consideration of the just and full sum of Sixty pounds Current money of Virginia by the said John Davis to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Henry Jones doth hereby acknowledge and therof acquit and discharge the said John Davis his heirs and assigns forever and him self therewith fully and intirely satisfied contented and paid he the said Henry Jones hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed released returned delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain sell alien convey release return deliver and confirm unto the said John Davis and to his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation messuage tract and parcel of land whereon the said Henry Jones formerly lived now in the occupation (as to the houses) of Dorothy Douglas situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Nettonway aforesaid on the Cattails swamp containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Joshua Whitney John Sharp Thomas Jayner Joseph Danson and the line of the lands whereon the said Henry Jones now lives and being the lands which the said Henry Jones bought of Alicajah Greffen also all that plantation messuage tract and parcel of land whereon the said Henry Jones now lives situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Nettonway aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and twenty acres be the same more or less and being all the land which the said Henry Jones bought of William Jayner bounded and described as by the said Jayners deed to the said Jones is expressed & declared and all the houses out houses edifices buildings woods vains waters and water courses low grounds Gardens orchards profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to said plantation messuages tracts and parcels of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the revenues and reversions remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and all the estate right title interest claim and demand of him the said Henry Jones of and
