This Indenture made this fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between Henry Jones of the County of Southampton and parish of Mottoway of the one part and John Davis administrator of Isaac Williams deceased of the County and parish aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Henry Jones for and in consideration of the just and full sum of Sixty pounds Current money of Virginia by the said John Davis to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Henry Jones doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said John Davis his heirs and assigns forever and himself therewith fully and intirely satisfied Antiented and paid he the said Henry Jones hath granted bargained sold alience enfeoffed released set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release set over deliver and confirm unto the said John Davis and to his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation messuge tract and parcel of land wherein the said Henry Jones formerly lived now in the occupation (as to the houses) of Dorothy Douglass situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Mottoway aforesaid on the Cattail swamp containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Joshua Whitley John Sharp Somer Jaynes Joseph Benson and the line of the lands wherein the said Henry Jones now lives and being the lands which the said Henry Jones bought of Micajah Griffen also all that plantation messuge tract and parcel of land wherein the said Henry Jones now lives estimate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Mottoway aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and twenty acres be the same more or less and being all the land which the said Henry Jones bought of William Jaynes bounded and described as by the said Jaynes did to the said Jones is expressed & declared and all the houses and houses edifices buildings woods wais waters and water courses law grounds gardens orchards profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to said plantation messuges to acts and parcels of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the revenues and reversions remaining and remaining rents issues and profits thereof and all the estate right title interest claim and demand of him the said Henry Jones of and
