the enacting and delivery of these presents by Lewis Jeyner of the said County
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge
the said Lewis Jeyner his heirs executors and administrators by these
presents have and by these presents do Remit Release and forever
quit claim unto the said Lewis Jeyner and to his heirs and assigns forever
all my right title interest use Trust property Claim or demand which
I now have or had of in ten to and certain tract or parcel of Land being
the tract whereon the said Lewis Jeyner now lives containing two
hundred and seventy five acres more or less which was conveyed to me
my heirs and assigns by one Indenture of trust bearing date the
twenty ninth day of April 1788 mine by the said Lewis Jeyner
