This Indenture ^{made} this thirtieth day of April in the year of our Lord 1793
Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety two Between Isaac Johnson and Arthur
Turner and Harris Johnson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the
one part and Thomas Edmunds of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth
that the said Isaac Johnson and Arthur Turner and Harris Johnson for and in
consideration of the sum of twenty one pounds seven shillings and six pence current
money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Edmunds the receipt
whereof they the said Isaac Johnson and Arthur Turner and Harris Johnson doth
hereby acknowledge they the said Isaac Johnson and Arthur Turner and Harris
Johnson have granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these
presents doth grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said
Thomas Edmunds his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being on the north side of Mattoway River in the County
of Southampton aforesaid containing forty two acres and three furlongs be-
the same more or less bounded as followeth To wit Beginning at a small black
oak on the side of Barrows Road then North thirty five degrees west
fifty two poles to a small white oak then North Sixteen degrees West twenty
six poles to a Black Oak on the side of Buckhorn Swamp then up
the edge of the said swamp to a white oak in the old Indian line
thence along the said Indian Line south fifty one degrees East one
hundred and twenty poles to Barrows Road thence down the said
Road to the beginning and also the Reversion and Reversions Remainder
and Remainders Rents Issues and services of the said premises and every part and
parcel thereof and all the estate Right title Interest Claim and demand what-
soever of them the said Isaac Johnson and Arthur Turner and Harris
Johnson of in and to the said Seat Tract or parcel of land and every part thereof
to have and to hold the said seat Tract or parcel of land and all and vinge-
lar the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with
the appurtenances unto the said Thomas Edmunds his heirs and assigns forever
to the only proper use and behoof of the said Thomas Edmunds his heirs
and assigns forever and the said Isaac Johnson and Arthur Turner and
Harris Johnson for themselves and their heirs the said seat Tract or
parcel of land and premises and every part thereof against themselves
and their heirs and against all and every person or persons whatsoever
to the said Thomas Edmunds his heirs and assigns shall and will
warrant and forever defend by these presents in witness whereof
the said Isaac Johnson and Arthur Turner and Harris Johnson
have hereunto set their hands and Seals the day and Year
above written
