This Indenture made this thirtieth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two Between Giles Vick of Southampton County and state of Virginia of the one part and James Barnes of the County aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Giles Vick and wife Delila for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ninety two pounds sixteen shillings and six pence Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said James Barnes the Receipt whereof the said Giles Vick and wife Delila doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Barnes his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying or being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by Estimation two hundred and fifty seven acres more or less and bounded as followeth To wit beginning at Pilgrim Vicks line on the branch thence up the said branch thence hundred & thirty nine poles To a Locust a corner of James Barnes land thence along his line north seventy six degrees east twenty four poles north sixty three Degrees east twenty five poles to a pine a corner of Pilas Vicks land thence along his line south thirty degrees east ninety two poles south thirty three degrees east twenty eight poles south thirty two Degrees east twenty eight poles south twenty five degrees east sixteen poles to a pine in John Jacksons line thence along his line south twenty four degrees east twenty poles south eighteen Degrees east ninety two and half poles to a white oak in Jack Vicks line thence along his line south seventy Degrees west eight poles south sixty two degrees west fifty six poles south sixty Degrees west one hundred and twenty eight and half poles south forty two degrees west six poles to the beginning with all trees woods meadows - Common of Pasture Profits commodities advantages emoluments and hereditaments whatsoever to the tract of land - Belonging or in any wise appurtenant or upon the same growing happening or arising and also the reversion reversions remainder and remainders unto services of the premises and every part thereof and also all the estate right title Interest Claim and demands whatsoever of him the said Giles Vick of in or to the same premises and every part thereof To have and To hold all and singular the s. premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said James Barnes his heirs and assigns To the only proper
