This Indenture made this 10th day of September 1792 and six-
teenth of American Independance between Willie Francis of Southamp-
ton County and state of Virginia of the one part and William Ed-
munds of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth, that the said
Willie Francis for an inconsideration twenty seven pounds fifteen
Shillings current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the
said William Edmunds before the Ensealing and delivery hereof
the receipt. whereof the said Willie Francis doth hereby acknowledge
and thereof doth acquaint the said William Edmunds his heirs ex-
ecutors administrators and assigns. Hath Granted Bargained
Sold Alien'd Released and confirmed & by these presents do grant
Bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said William Edmunds
his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract parcel or Dividend
of land, containing by Survey thirty seven acres more or less
situate lying and being in the county aforesaid and bounded as
followeth (To wit) Beginning at a post oak in William Balders
line (alias, John Coggins dec. thence north 47 degrees west 70 pole
to a white oak stump in a small branch that leads down into the
pole branch thence up the said branch south 11 degrees wt 62.
pole to a pine now a corner tree thence, thence S. 52 degrees E. 78 ft
pole to a black oak in Jacob Turners line, thence North 29 degrees
