

A court held for the county of Southampton the 13th day of September 1792. This Indenture and the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by Benjamin Worrell and Mary his wife she being first privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded—

This Indenture made this 15th day of April in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between Holaday Revel and Sally his wife of the county of Southampton & state of Virginia of the one part and Elijah Worrell of the county of Virginia witnesseth that the said Holaday Revel and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds to him in hand paid by the said Elijah Worrell the receipt whereof the said Holaday Revel and Sally his wife hath acknowledged them selves fully satisfied for one hundred and eleven acres of land more or less situate lying and being in the said county of Southampton and bounded as followeth (to wit) beginging at a pine in the cypress swamp in Elijah Worrells line thence along the said Worrells line to a pine corner tree thence along a line of marked trees to a pine in the head of the South prong of the haw branch thence down the run of the said branch to the cypress swamp thence up the run of the said swamp to the pine at the beginning To have and to hold all and singular the above bargained premises to him the said Elijah Worrell his heirs and assigns for ever to the proper use and behoof of them and every of them and the said Holaday Revel and his wife Sally at the time of sealing and delivering of these presences am lawfully seized of the above land with the appertinances thereunto belonging in fee in
