This Indenture made this twelfth day Sept: one thousand seven hundred & ninety two between James Wilkison of the one part & Burrwell Bryant of the other Witnesseth that the said Wilkison for and in consideration of the sum of six pounds nineteen shillings & 3^d V Currency in hand paid by the said Bryant hath bargained sold & delivered unto the said Bryant a certain tract of Land & premises containing by Estimation nine acres be the same more or less & bounded as followeth Vizt. Beginning at a pine thence N 66 degrees E 91 pole thence N 25 west 68 pole thence S: 23 w: 9 pole thence S: 4. w: 36 poles thence S: 30, w: 62 p & from thence to the beginning. To have and to hold to the s^d Land & unto the s^d Bryant & to his heirs forever & the s^d Wilkison doth for himself his heirs &c. forever warrant & defend the title of the same against all & every person or persons whatsoever in witness whereof the said Wilkison hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this day and year above written.
