This Indenture made this 3rd day of April one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between James Story and Esther Story on the one part & Williams Vick of the other part each of Southampton County witnesseth that the said James Story and his wife for & in consideration of the sum of fourteen pounds ten shillings current money of Virginia to them paid by the said Williams Vick hath granted and confirmed in by these presents doth for ever grant and confirm unto the said Williams Vick his heirs and assigns a certain parcel of land containing twenty nine acres bounded as follows beginning at a pine a corner of Gloviers land on the east side of Arthurs Swamp thence north fifty four degrees west seventy two poles to a light wood post thence North twenty three degrees east seventy two poles to a red oak thence South thirty three degrees east one hundred and six poles to a bay tree thence south sixty four degrees west thirty six poles to the beginning together with all Houses out houses gardens orchards ways waters and water courses woods & underwoods minerals and all other the profits and commodities thereto belonging ~~thereto~~ and in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said premises with the appertenuances unto the said Williams Vick his heirs and assigns forever with the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents issues & profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof And the said James Story & Esther his wife for themselves their heirs Exors. and administrators doth covenant and agree with the said Williams Vick his heirs and assigns in the following manner that is to say that they the said James Story & Esther Story at the time of signing and sealing these presents lawfully seized and possessed of the said land and that the same is fully and clearly
